The thinking that I have been doing with several other Grubb related people - mainly practitioners - could be another brick in the wall. It all started with work I did about 15 years ago, training the Inspectors of the Football Licensing Authority when we had to look closely at the Hillsborough disaster and its aftermath, especially in creating an internal climate of organisational/ corporate shame within the South Yorkshire Police. It took years to get to grips with that and included the service's failure to handle the child abuse scandals in its area, Rochdale, Rotherham etc."

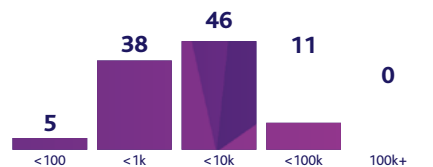

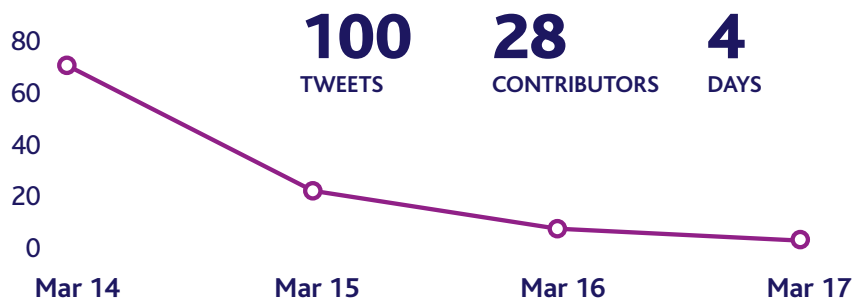

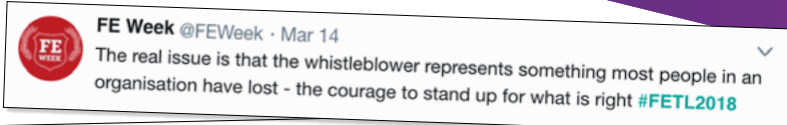
